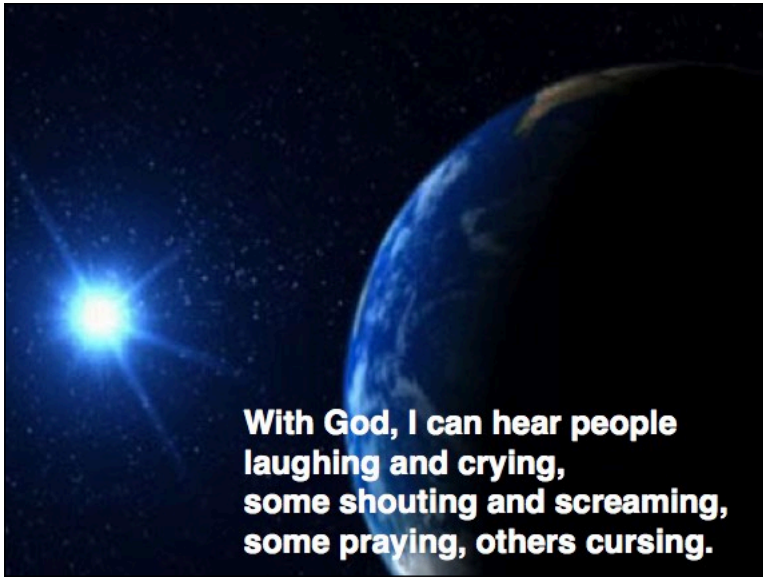
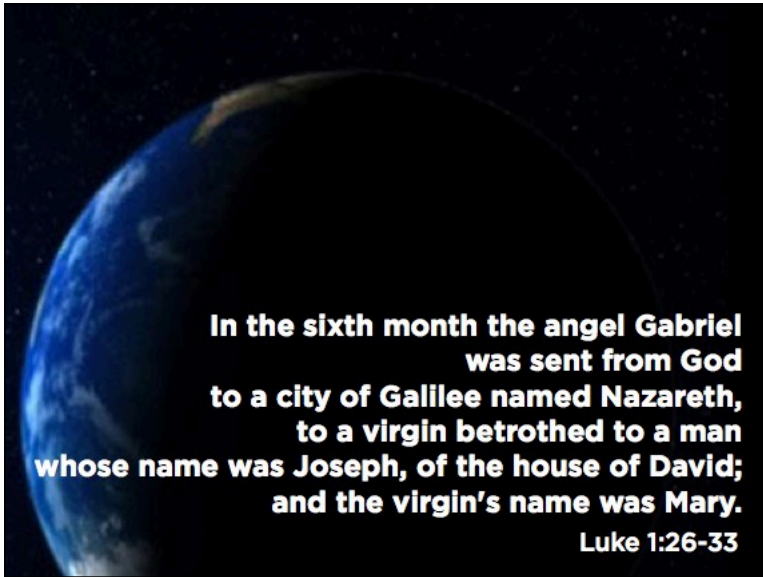

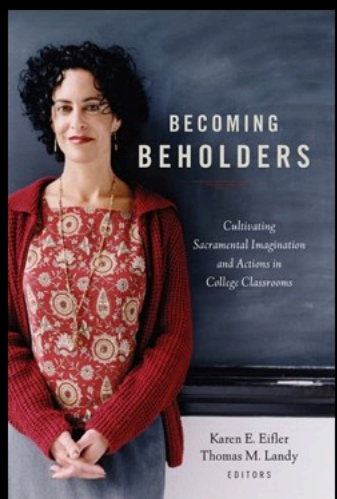
Painted on each

HALF-CLOSED EYES.



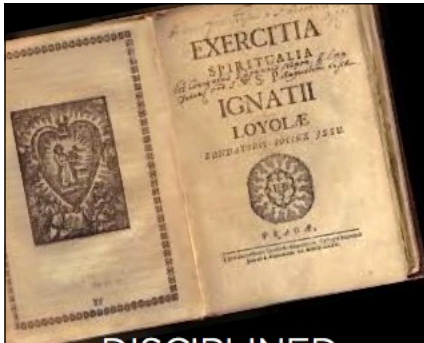
