## **STRUCTURED REFLECTION 01**

It is through REFLECTION on IDEAS and CONCEPTS that they acquire MEANING. So this exercise is intended to make what you heard yesterday and this morning *relevant* to you.

We have discussed the following important **IGNATIAN VALUES** which we have tried to define and clarify so far in this workshop:

- \* MAGIS as a non-competitive "win-win" drive for excellence
- \* DISCERNMENT as in-depth conversation (with listening and reflecting)
- \* CURA PERSONALIS and authentic collaboration with others
- \* Promotion of COMPETENCE among students, where COMPETENCE is defined as *transformative* and *collaborative*

Reflect on these ideas using your *personal experience* as an educator working in a Jesuit school. **Choose two (2) of the Ignatian values above, and recall a PERSONAL EXPERIENCE of:** 

(a) an **EXEMPLARY MOMENT**: a time when you witnessed or experienced how this Ignatian value is lived out in the classroom or in the school;

(b) a **MODEL**: someone in the school who showed you and inspired you through his or her personal example; OR

(c) a **CRISIS/PROBLEM:** an experience in the school where a lack or violation of these Ignatian values led to a difficult situation.
