Case Study

Choose **ONE** of the following case studies and use the worksheet on the **Ignatian Discernment Process** to come to a conclusion about your decision

Case Study 1:

A student at your school has been very badly behaved over a long period of time and has not responded to anyone of the strategies people have tried to use to modify the student's behaviour. Staff are placing pressure on you to expel the child from the school. The student is the child of a very large benefactor to your school and you risk loosing the money. As a result some staff will loose their jobs.

Case Study 2:

A Colleague of yours is having a difficult time financially and his child has become very ill and needs very expensive medicine to get better.

He has been organising a trip and has access to money that he is thinking about using. All costs of the trip have been covered and there is access funds which he could use.

What do you decide? How did you make the decision?

Case study 3:

Your school has been given you a very substantial amount of money to use for whatever purpose you are inclined. The money may be used for the school or for some other purpose that you feel inclined.
