JCAP Secondary Education Teacher Exchange Program

Draft Guidelines, May 2018

Objectives:

- 1. To promote the universal dimension of the Society of Jesus by providing teachers at Jesuit schools an opportunity to teach at a Jesuit school in another country
- 2. To facilitate, for selected students at Jesuit schools, an experience of dialogue with other cultures by providing them with a teacher from another country
- 3. To deepen collaboration between schools and among teachers in JCAP

Operational Guidelines:

- 1. As an exchange program, a participating school is ready to both send and receive a teacher at the secondary level (high school)
- 2. Duration of the program is three months or one academic quarter.
- 3. The preferred subject area to be taught (in English; unless a language course) will be manifested by interested schools, and matching will be coordinated by the JCAP Education Secretariat
- 4. The participating teacher will team-teach with a local teacher, to address concerns about the academic calendar, duration of the program, etc., so as not to disrupt the regular operations of the school

Obligations of participating schools:

For the teacher to be sent

- 1. To select the best possible candidate for the job
- 2. To continue paying the salary and benefits of the teacher who is sent
- 3. To sponsor the airfare and other travel expenses, including visa fees
- 4. To recognize, as appropriate, participation in the program in the performance appraisal of the teacher

For the teacher to be received

- 1. To facilitate integration with the receiving academic department, possibly assigning a faculty member to serve as the visiting teacher's mentor
- 2. To provide single-room accommodation for the duration of the program
- 3. To provide a modest living allowance to cover food and any daily local travel expenses
