REFLECTION

"The memory, the understanding, the imagination, and the feelings are used to capture the **meaning** and the essential **value** of what is being studied, to discover its **relationship** with other aspect of knowledge and human activity, and to appreciate its **implications** in the ongoing search for truth and freedom." [47]

Ignatian Pedagogy 1993

a search for ...

- * **MEANING**
- * **VALUE or SIGNIFICANCE**
- * **RELATIONSHIPS or CONNECTIONS**
- * **IMPLICATIONS**

REFLECTION

- * Make **connections** with:
 - other topics and texts in and beyond the subject,
 - events (historical + current)
 - personal experience

* **Organize** by relating to a **bigger picture**

INSIGHTS

enable us to organize and file what we learn for future access by:

- * **synthesizing** concepts
- * **connecting** them with other lessons in the same course or even other courses, and finally,
- * **building a conceptual framework**

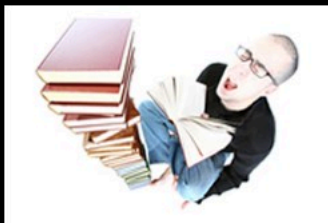


Which one sounds like an **Insight**?

The plot refers to the sequence of events in a narrative, usually consisting of

- (1) the exposition of the situation,
- (2) the rising action (as a result of conflict),
- (3) the climax or turning point,
- (4) the falling action, and
- (5) the resolution.

Every single element in a given literary text (such as a narrative, poem, or essay) ought to contribute to the author's purpose (be it a message or an artistic/emotional effect).

What is an **INSIGHT**?

NOT A DEFINITION
not just a fact

NOT AN OPINION
not just a personal opinion
or subjective feeling

IS A JUDGMENT
an assertion or theory
neither **FACT** nor **OPINION**
DECIDABLE + DEFENSIBLE

What is an INSIGHT?

PROVOKES
THOUGHT
+ TALK

interesting + even controversial
makes you think and ask questions
with no single correct answer
no obvious or self-evident solution

DEBATABLE
+ DEVELOPING

ESSENTIAL
+ CENTRAL

at the heart of the matter
at the core of the discipline
helps connect & organize content knowledge
offers access to bigger picture
